5 WHEREAS, According to the American Dietetic Association, vegetarian diets are  
6 associated with reduced risk for obesity, coronary artery disease, hypertension, diabetes  
7 mellitus, colorectal cancer, lung cancer, and kidney disease; and

8 WHEREAS, Animal agriculture has been linked to extensive environmental damage,  
9 including a habitat loss, topsoil erosion, and global warming; and

10 WHEREAS, The treatment of animals used in animal agriculture, including depravation  
11 of light and air, de-beaking of chicken, and the use of bovine growth hormones, raises  
12 significant ethical concerns; and

13 WHEREAS, The Great American Meatout is the world's largest and oldest annual  
14 grassroots diet education campaign; and

15 WHEREAS, March 20, 2002, the first day of spring, affords all Americans the  
16 opportunity to kick the meat habit and explore a wholesome, nonviolent diet of grains,  
17 vegetables and fruits; and

18 WHEREAS, This March, educators, students, health care providers, consumer and  
19 animal right activists, and thousand of other caring people from all over the United States will  
20 hold colorful educational events in honor of a meat-free diet; and

21 WHEREAS, The Great American Meatout affords Americans the opportunity to show  
22 respect and compassion for all living creatures; and

23 WHEREAS, The Great American Meatout provides Americans with a variety of  
24 healthier food choices; and

2 impacts on the natural environment; now, therefore, be it
