17 has continuously been run by ex-cons for ex-cons; and,

18 WHEREAS, Residents learn not only academic and vocational
19 skills, but also interpersonal, social survival skills,
20 attitudes and values to develop the self-reliance necessary to
21 live in mainstream society drug-free, successfully and
22 legitimately; and,

23 WHEREAS, Thousands of men and women have graduated into
24 society as taxpaying citizens leading successful lives,


