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3 **Resolution concurring with the Controller's certification that janitorial services can be**
4 **practically performed by private contractor for lower cost than similar services**
5 **performed by City and County employees.**

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7 WHEREAS, The electorate of the City and County of San Francisco passed
8 Proposition "J" in November, 1976 adding Section 8.300-1 to the Charter that was replaced by
9 Charter Section 10.104.15 allowing City departments to contract with private companies for
10 specific services which can be performed for a lower cost than similar work by City and
11 County employees; and,

12 WHEREAS, The Department of Parking and Traffic wishes to re-bid its existing
13 contract for janitorial services at the Parking Authority's twenty one off-street, metered parking
14 lots and five Department of Parking and Traffic facilities; and,

15 WHEREAS, The Controller certified on December 7, 2001 that said services can be
16 performed at lower cost to the City and County by a contractor than by employees of the City
17 and County; now, therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors hereby concurs with the Controller's
19 certification and authorizes the Department of Parking and Traffic to contract for janitorial
20 services for FY 2001-2002.
