6 WHEREAS, On March 23, 2002, the Northern California champion Archbishop  
7 Riordan basketball team beat the Southern California champion Compton Centennial 47-43  
8 to win the California Interscholastic Federation Division III state championship; and,

9 WHEREAS, The Archbishop Riordan Crusaders became the first men’s basketball  
10 team from the City and County of San Francisco to win a state championship since the 1926  
11 St. Ignatius Wildcats beat Lemoore 20-11; and,

12 WHEREAS, In addition to being the state champions, the Crusaders are the two time  
13 defending Division III Northern California Champions; and

14 WHEREAS, Richard Forslund, coach of the Crusaders, has coached hundreds of  
15 youth as Riordan’s head coach and as a youth league coach prior to his tenure at Archbishop  
16 Riordan; now, therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
18 commends the Archbishop Riordan High School basketball team for winning the California  
19 Division III men’s basketball championship.


