[Accept-Expend Federal Grant]

Resolution authorizing the Department of Children, Youth and Their Families to accept and expend a grant ^{up to \$484,000} ~~in the amount of \$575,000~~ from the United States Department of Agriculture for Mayor's Summer Food Service Program.

WHEREAS, The United States Department of Agriculture provides funds to the City and County of San Francisco to operate the Summer Food Service Program; and,

WHEREAS, the funding will provide children ages 0-17 with free meals during the summer months from June to August 2002; and,

WHEREAS, an average of 4,000 children are served meals each day during the summer at 85 food service sites throughout the City; and,

WHEREAS, the grant terms prohibit indirect costs; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco hereby authorizes the Department of Children, Youth and Their Families to apply for, accept, and expend funds ^{up to \$484,000} ~~in the amount of \$575,000~~ from the United States Department of Agriculture to sponsor the Mayor's Summer Food Service Program.


