1 [Liquor License, 1750 Fulton Street]

2 **Resolution determining that the transfer of a Type 21 off-sale general alcoholic**
3 **beverage control license from 17 Kearny Street to 1750 Fulton Street to Paulette**
4 **Dewire for Albertson's Inc. will serve the public convenience and necessity of the**
5 **people of the City and County of San Francisco, in accordance with Section**
6 **23958.4 of the California Business and Professions Code; with conditions.**

8 WHEREAS, Paulette Dewire is seeking transfer of a Type 21 off-sale general
9 alcoholic beverage control license for Albertson's Inc. located at 1750 Fulton Street;
10 and,

11 WHEREAS, The City Planning Department has verified that the area is properly
12 zoned; and, conditional use has been secured from the Planning Department.

13 WHEREAS, The Police Department recommends that the liquor license
14 application be approved with conditions; now, therefore, be it

15 RESOLVED, That in accordance with Section 23958.4 of the California Business
16 and Professions Code, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San
17 Francisco hereby determines for the foregoing reasons that the transfer of a Type 21
18 off-sale general alcoholic beverage control license from 17 Kearny Street to 1750 Fulton
19 Street for Paulette Dewire for Albertson's Inc., will serve the public convenience and
20 necessity of the people of the City and County of San Francisco.

21 Conditions: (1) The hours of operation shall not exceed 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
22 each day of the week with the exception of a pharmacy that is open 24 hours a day; (2)
23 Delivery trucks associated with the supermarket operator shall be limited to the hours of
24 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. daily. Delivery hours for smaller trucks not associated with the
25 supermarket operator (such as bread trucks and other independent vendors) shall be

1 limited to the period of 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Exceptions may be made for extreme and
2 unusual emergency situations, but deliveries shall be scheduled to anticipate traffic
3 delays, inclement weather or other typical occurrences in order to avoid delivery activity
4 outside of the permitted delivery hours; (3) The hours of sales of alcoholic beverages at
5 Albertson's shall not exceed 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.; (4) The pharmacy currently
6 planned to operate at the site shall not offer for sale alcoholic beverages without first
7 receiving permission from the City and State Agencies.




