RESOLUTION NO. 287-02

1 [FEDERAL FUNDING - HOME PROGRAM]

3 Resolution authorizing the Mayor of the City and County of San Francisco to accept and
4 expend a grant from the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for a total
5 amount of \$7,865,000 for the HOME Program authorized under TITLE II of the National
6 Affordable Housing Act of 1990, Public Law Number 101-625, and approving the HOME
7 Program description as described in the 2002 Action Plan for San Francisco's Consolidated
8 Plan. Indirect costs associated with the acceptance of these grant funds will be paid by the
9 Community Development Block Grant funds ; placing \$20,000 on reserve.

11 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco is an eligible city for purposes of
12 receiving funds from the HOME Investment Partnership (HOME) Program, and has received a
13 formula allocation of Seven Million Eight-Hundred Sixty-Five Thousand (\$7,865,000); and

14 WHEREAS, The HOME Program will be used to provide funds for the development,
15 acquisition and rehabilitation of low-income housing, in accordance with the Consolidated Plan
16 Action Plan to be submitted to HUD on or before May 15, 2002; and

17 WHEREAS, The Mayor's Office of Housing has prepared a description of the proposed use
18 of HOME funds to carry out the goals of the City's Consolidated Plan Action Plan and the
19 Residence Element of the General Plan, and has incorporated that description into the Action Plan;
20 and

21 WHEREAS, A portion of the administrative and direct costs of administering the HOME
22 program are to be paid from the 2002 allocation; and

24 WHEREAS, The remainder of the administrative and direct costs of administering

1 the HOME program is an eligible Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) expense,
2 and will be paid from CDBG funds through the 2002 Community Development Program;
3 now, therefore, be it

4 RESOLVED, that the Mayor of the City and County of San Francisco is authorized
5 to accept and expend the HOME Program from the Department of Housing and Urban
6 Development according to the Federal Rules and Regulations for the program and the
7 Consolidated Plan Action Plan; and be it

8 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors hereby approve the proposed
9 Program Description as incorporated into the Consolidated Plan Action Plan, on file with
10 the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and incorporated herein by reference ; and be it

11 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor is hereby authorized to submit
12 documentation and certification required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban
13 Development; and be it



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
