6 WHEREAS, Public schools in California are chronically under funded; and

7 WHEREAS, In order for students to meet the achievement goals embraced by the San
8 Francisco Unified School District, adequate funding and services are required; and

9 WHEREAS, Participation in the political process is one of the valuable educational
10 experiences that students should have; and

11 WHEREAS, The San Francisco community and its participating organizations and
12 individuals have always been supportive of increasing resources for public education; and

13 WHEREAS, The Governor’s proposed budget does not include significant increases or
14 adequate resources to fund necessary educational and support services for public schools in
15 California; and

16 WHEREAS, The Oakland Unified School District, Berkeley Unified School District,
17 West Contra Costa Unified School District, the Service Employees International Union and
18 other school districts and organizations are planning a day of legislative action on May 8,
19 2002 in Sacramento; and

20 WHEREAS, A cohesive effort to lobby in Sacramento for education funding would be
21 most effective on May 8, 2002, also known as the National Day of the Teacher, and now,
22 therefore, be it

23 RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors declares its commitment to
24 support the above mentioned legislative activity and will help organization the logistics of
25 transportation for the event.
