7 Environmental Grant and Mentorship Program; and,

8 WHEREAS, The participating high schools received a grant of \$1,000 to do a project
9 on water quality, water conservation and/or wastewater pollution prevention; and,

10 WHEREAS, The participating high schools are also assigned an SFPUC employee
11 with expertise on their project who acts as their mentor through the six weeks of the
12 Environmental Mentorship Program; and,

13 WHEREAS, The participating schools present their project findings to students at other
14 schools at the Environmental Summit in a roundtable session; and,

15 WHEREAS, Balboa High School has participated in the SFPUC Environmental
16 Mentorship Program for the last five years; and,

17 WHEREAS, Balboa High School has used the funding for the last five years to
18 investigate the water quality of lakes in San Francisco, such as Lake Merced, Stern Grove
19 and Lake McNab at McLaren Park; and,

20 WHEREAS, Balboa High School students under the leadership of Science Department
21 Director Stan DeBella and teacher Maia Willcox did an outstanding job in presenting their
22 project and were selected by their peers as “Best Roundtable Presentation” at the fifth annual
23 SFPUC Environmental Summit; now, therefore, be it
