13 recommendations to the San Francisco Unified School District; and,

14 WHEREAS, For the past three years, the LSSA has worked tirelessly to place social
15 workers and nurses back into the school district as permanent fixtures; and,

16 WHEREAS, As a result of their persistence and hard work, the school district recently
17 approved the funding of 10 Social Workers and 10 Nurses for the STAR schools through their
18 general fund; now, therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco commend the Learning
20 Support Services Advocates Coalition for their exemplary efforts to expand learning support
21 services as a permanent part of schools in San Francisco Unified School District; and be it,




