7 WHEREAS, AIM is a sequential, interdisciplinary and curriculum-based music program
8 designed to educate grade school students about the music of many cultures; and

9 WHEREAS, Since its inception in 1988 it is one of the most far reaching community
10 music education programs of any Symphony Orchestra in the country; and

11 WHEREAS, In recent years the program has expanded and now reaches every 1st –
12 5th grade student in the San Francisco Unified School District; and

13 WHEREAS, In addition to servicing all of San Francisco's public schools, the program
14 also covers numerous private and parochial schools, reaching over 26,000 students in a total
15 of 91 schools in the city; and

16 WHEREAS, AIM strives to introduce San Francisco's children to a wide range of music
17 including classical, jazz, Afro-Cuban, and salsa and presents ensembles featuring acclaimed
18 local artists; and

19 WHEREAS, Elementary schools are provided a plethora of resources and services
20 including a trip to a San Francisco Symphony concert, four in-school ensemble concerts,
21 professional development sessions for teachers and principals, supplemental classroom
22 resources such as videos, CD's and instruments, and a journal for each student; and

23 WHEREAS, As a vital part of the San Francisco Symphony's commitment to
24 community service, the entire AIM program is provided free of charge to schools and
25 teachers; now, therefore be it




