5 WHEREAS, On June 15, 1990, striking Century City janitors and supporters were brutally  
6 beaten by Los Angeles police during the Century City Los Angeles riot; and,

7 WHEREAS, In remembrance of that day, SEIU janitors take action every June 15<sup>th</sup> in cities  
8 nationwide and in countries around the world reminding us all that basic fairness is worth fighting for;  
9 and,

10 WHEREAS, The overwhelming majority of janitors are immigrants and immigrants in this  
11 country are hard working people, who are trying to provide for a better future for their families; and,

12 WHEREAS, This year thousands of people around the country participated in supporting the  
13 principle that all working people—regardless of race, background, gender or immigration status—  
14 deserve a living wage, affordable health coverage, and a retirement with dignity; now, therefore, be it

15 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby  
16 recognize June 15, 2002 as Justice for Janitors Day.
