3 **Resolution urging the Conference Committee of the California State Legislature to give**  
4 **\$3.5 million to fund the Supportive Housing Initiative Act (SHIA).**

6 WHEREAS, The Supportive Housing Initiative Act (SHIA) program has enabled  
7 homeless individuals and families with special needs to have access to quality affordable  
8 housing and supportive services; and

9 WHEREAS, SHIA is a critical component of a long-term effort to end long-term  
10 homelessness among those with chronic and persistent health conditions; and

11 WHEREAS, As the only state-wide program dedicated to funding supportive housing  
12 for adults with disabilities, it addresses the needs of California's most vulnerable residents;  
13 and

14 WHEREAS, For the past three years, SHIA provided \$42.4 million dollars of funding  
15 which resulted in 8,300 units of supportive housing serving adults and children in rural, urban  
16 and suburban areas; and

17 WHEREAS, SHIA has a proven record of success – a recent evaluation revealed that  
18 96% of the clients remained in supportive housing and one-third had increases in their income  
19 level; now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the City and Count of San Francisco  
21 does hereby urges the Conference Committee of the California State Legislature to fund the  
22 Supportive Housing Act at \$3.5 million; and be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors shall send copies of  
24 this resolution to Governor Gray Davis, to the California Legislative Delegation, and to the

2 Capitol Building, Room 3060, Sacramento, CA 95814.




