3 Resolution amending Resolution No. 02-0729, which supported a unified San
4 Francisco School District, by amending the first whereas clause to clarify the
5 meaning of the resolution.

7 WHEREAS, On June 3, 2002, the San Francisco Board of Supervisors
8 unanimously passed Resolution No. 02-0729, supporting a unified San Francisco
9 School District; and,

10 WHEREAS, After its passage, a grammatical error was found in the first
11 paragraph that needs to be corrected in order to clarify the meaning of the resolution;
12 and,

13 WHEREAS, The first whereas clause of Resolution No. 02-0729 stating that, "A
14 proposal has recently been advanced that would split San Francisco's Unified School
15 District in half with hopes of increasing community involvement within the schools and
16 ensure that all high school students can attend their own local school; and," should be
17 amended; and,

18 WHEREAS, This whereas clause should be replaced with a corrected whereas
19 clause that reads, "WHEREAS, Splitting the San Francisco Unified School District
20 would polarize San Francisco racially and economically-segregating schools,
21 increasing achievement gaps and reducing educational opportunities for San Francisco
22 youth; and," now, therefore, be it

23 RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco Board of Supervisors
24 hereby amends Resolution No. 02-0729, by deleting the first whereas clause and
25 replacing it with "WHEREAS, Splitting the San Francisco Unified School District would


