9 WHEREAS, The concrete section of the Western Approaches of the I-80, Bay Bridge  
10 from the West Anchorage to Fifth Street was weakened during the 1989 Loma Prieta  
11 earthquake, and

12 WHEREAS, The State has begun to implement its plan to retrofit and rebuild that  
13 portion of the Freeway; and,

14 WHEREAS, The Departments of Parking and Traffic and Public Works staff have  
15 worked closely with the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), the Municipal  
16 Railway (Muni), local businesses and residents on a daily basis to coordinate all plans and  
17 designs for all temporary detours on City streets as part of the demolition and reconstruction  
18 of that portion of the Freeway; and,

19 WHEREAS, Caltrans has requested that aforementioned departments work together to  
20 obtain all necessary clearances for and to design, prepare Plans, Specifications and Estimate  
21 (PS&E), advertise, open bids, award, administer and complete a construction contract to  
22 furnish and install nine (9) overhead sign structures and fifty-five (55) sign panels for traffic  
23 control of its West Approach Seismic Retrofit Project; and,


1 WHEREAS, Indirect costs are ineligible according to federal and state rules and






