WHEREAS, Bayview LEARNS is an innovative, community-designed effort that provides youth with a comprehensive, community-based summer school program; and

WHEREAS, Bayview LEARNS grew out of a yearlong civic engagement process in which SF LEARNS conducted interviews and focus groups with youth, families, CBO staff, and educators, and community members to create a vision for increasing learning and strengthening community in Bayview; and,

WHEREAS, Bayveiw LEARNS worked with many community based organizations to create a comprehensive program that integrated community issues relevant to youth's lives into the academic curriculum; and,

WHEREAS, The success of Bayview LEARNS is evidenced in the tremendous outcomes the program achieved; and,

WHEREAS, Over 80% of the students enrolled in Bayview LEARNS were considered by SFUSD to be " educationally at-risk, yet 89% of these students passed their courses and received school credits; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco Board of Supervisors extends their highest recommendation to Bayview LEARNS for their efforts to provide youth in the Bayview with a comprehensive, community-based summer school program.
