3 **Resolution urging the Municipal Transportation Agency and the Department of Parking**
4 **and Traffic to proceed with the planned integration of the Department of Parking and**
5 **Traffic into the Municipal Transportation Agency effective on July 1st, 2002.**

7 WHEREAS, In November of 1999, the voters of the City and County of San Francisco
8 voted overwhelmingly for Proposition E and comprehensive reform of San Francisco's
9 transportation system; and,

10 WHEREAS, Prop E included an enhanced Transit-First policy designed to provide
11 faster and more reliable transit service by giving transit vehicles priority over automobiles;
12 and,

13 WHEREAS, The Municipal Railway has made significant progress in improving service,
14 as most recently measured by Rescue MUNI's annual survey, but still has significant
15 opportunities to speed up service by implementing projects such as Bus Rapid Transit; and,

16 WHEREAS, the effective enforcement of parking and traffic regulations and transit
17 priority rules in particular, is essential for MUNI to provide faster and more reliable service;
18 and,

19 WHEREAS, The promotion of alternative transportation such as bicycling depends on
20 effective management of San Francisco's streets and enforcement of traffic laws; and,

21 WHEREAS, San Francisco voters have repeatedly rejected attempts to dismantle or
22 otherwise modify the Department of Parking and Traffic; now, therefore, be it

23 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
24 does hereby urge the Municipal Transportation Agency ("MTA) and the Department of Parking

1 and Traffic ("DPT") to proceed with the planned integration on July 1 of the DPT into the MTA;
2 and, be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby extend its
4 gratitude to the employees of both the DPT and the MTA for their hard work to ensure that
5 San Francisco's streets are safe and its transit system is as fast and reliable as possible.




