7 WHEREAS, The electorate of the City and County of San Francisco passed
8 Proposition J in November, 1976 adding Section 10.104.15 to the Charter allowing City
9 Departments to contract with private companies for specific services which can be practically
10 performed for a lower cost than similar work by City and County employees, and,

12 WHEREAS, The Police Department has sought a proposal for services from a
13 contractor and wishes to contract and,

15 WHEREAS, The Controller has determined on May 13, 2002 that said services can be
16 performed at lower cost by private contractor than by employees of the City and County for
17 the Fiscal Year July 1, 2002: now, therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors hereby concurs, retroactively, with the
20 Controller’s certification and approves that the Police Department may contract for Crime
21 Prevention.
