8 WHEREAS, The St. John's Educational Thresholds Center (SJETC) was founded in
9 the 1960s as a non- profit, youth development organization; and,

10 WHEREAS, Over 1,100 youth and their families participate in SJETC programs every
11 year; and,

12 WHEREAS, The SJETC recognizes and encourages the gifts of Mission District youth
13 working with youth from ages 5 to 22 and their families to promote personal and community
14 development; and,

15 WHEREAS, The SJETC also provides educational, career, community activism,
16 recreation, leadership, health and visual arts programs to the Mission District youth; and,

17 WHEREAS, Youth participants of the SJETC Summer School were the first to
18 recognize the need for a park in the North Mission; and,

19 WHEREAS, For seven years, participants of the SJETC Summer School have worked
20 for the creation of a park in North Mission; and,

21 WHEREAS the SJETC Summer School participants have successfully secured funding
22 from both the City and the State, as well as obtained the location on Hoff Street for
23 construction; and,

1 WHEREAS, On Saturday, July 27, 2002 the SJETC will celebrate its 30th Anniversary
2 at the future site of the Hoff Street Park; now, therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco and the Board of Supervisors
4 commends the St. John's Educational Thresholds Center for 30 years of dedicated service to
5 the Community and in particular the youth of the North Mission; and, be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That The City and County of San Francisco and the Board of
7 Supervisors commends youth of St. John's Educational Thresholds Center Summer School
8 for successfully lobbying the City and State for the creation of the first recreational park in the
9 North Mission.




