2 **Resolution consolidating the Bay Area Rapid Transit District Election for Director’s**  
3 **Seat in District 8 and Special District Election for a Seismic Safety Bond to be held in**  
4 **the City and County of San Francisco on November 5, 2002 with the General Municipal**  
5 **Election scheduled for the same date, and providing that the election shall be the same**  
6 **as for the General Municipal Election.**

8 WHEREAS, A General Municipal Election is scheduled to be held in the City and  
9 County of San Francisco on November 5, 2002 for the purpose of voting on candidates for  
10 local office and on proposed charter amendments and other measures to be submitted to the  
11 voters; and,

13 WHEREAS, The Bay Area Rapid Transit District (“BART”) Board of Directors is  
14 scheduled to hold an election in the City and County of San Francisco on November 5, 2002;  
15 and,

16 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors believes that it is in the best interests of the  
17 public that these elections be consolidated, as authorized by law; now, therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED, That pursuant to California Elections Code Sections 14,000 et. seq. and  
19 10402.5, and related sections, the BART District Election for Director’s Seat in District 8 and  
20 Special District Election for a Seismic Safety Bond to be held in the City and County of San  
21 Francisco on November 5, 2002 shall be and hereby are consolidated with the General  
22 Municipal Election scheduled for the same date; and, be it

1           FURTHER RESOLVED, That the voting precincts, polling places, and officers for the  
2 election shall in every case be the same; that there shall be only one set of election officers in  
3 each precinct, to wit: the election officers to be appointed by the Director of Elections for each  
4 precinct; that the candidates and measures, and bond proposals, and candidates for the  
5 Board of Directors of BART shall be set forth on the ballots provided for said election; that the  
6 election shall be held in all respects as though there were only one election, and that all  
7 returns shall be canvassed by the Director of Elections, as provided in the California Elections  
8 Code.
