15 WHEREAS, The Board finds it to be in the public interest to donate the surplus van to
16 the City of Concord for use in its law enforcement emergency response activities, now,
17 therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED, That the former San Francisco police van described above be donated to
19 the City of Concord Police Department.
