9 WHEREAS, Fifty years ago the people of San Francisco erected a monument to the
10 honor and glory of their namesake Guadalcanal Battle Cruiser, the USS San Francisco; and

11 WHEREAS, It is through the dedication and bravery of young men and women who
12 have fought for our country that we enjoy our freedom today; and

13 WHEREAS, Services are held each year at the USS San Francisco Monument on
14 Memorial Day for men and women who sacrificed their lives for our country; and

15 WHEREAS, The veterans from the USS San Francisco Association intend to
16 complete the USS San Francisco Monument by adding two black granite plaques displaying
17 the USS San Francisco and the history of the Guadalcanal battles, to become a permanent
18 feature of the monument; now, therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
20 urge the National Park Service, Golden Gate National Recreation Area, to maintain the
21 existing configuration of the USS San Francisco Monument site to the memory and the glory
22 of the servicemen and women who sacrificed for our freedom; and, be it further

23 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
24 urge the National Parks Service, Golden Gate National Recreation Area, to maintain the
25 bronze plaques honoring the USS San Francisco; and, be it
