3 **Resolution urging the State legislature and Governor Davis to make SB 2065,**
4 **California's low level radioactive waste reporting requirement, into state law.**

6 WHEREAS, SB 2065 would require California's low-level radioactive waste (LLRW)
7 generators to report annually on the type and amount of waste they produce and how much is
8 stored and/shipped for disposal; and

9
10 WHEREAS, an annual survey of LLRW generators will provide the public and
11 decision-makers with a baseline of information about the LLRW generated in the state; and,

12 WHEREAS, this information would be available to the public and to elected officials;
13 and,

14 WHEREAS, this information will aid the public and elected officials in developing
15 informed LLRW management policies for the state; and,

16 WHEREAS, all other hazardous waste producers in California must report annually in
17 a similar manner; and,

18 WHEREAS, an annual survey will encourage source reduction and compliance with
19 environmental laws; and,

20 WHEREAS, an annual survey is essential for the public's right to know; and,

21 WHEREAS, the survey will promote environmental justice principals by providing
22 communities with information relevant to the protection of public health; and,

23 WHEREAS, California's LLRW Management Task Force recommends an annual
24 survey; and,

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WHEREAS, the stakeholder group (Atkinson Committee) appointed by Governor Davis to develop LLRW policy for California unanimously recommended that the state conduct an annual survey of all LLRW generators; and,

WHEREAS, an annual survey will be of benefit to California's LLRW generators; and,

WHEREAS, no new funds will be required to conduct the annual survey since funds already exist in the Radiation Control Fund; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco Board of Supervisors urge the State Legislature and Governor Davis to make SB 2065 into state law.
