12 WHEREAS, The State of California, acting through its Department of Transportation  
13 (Caltrans), is in the process of implementing its Seismic Retrofit Program in the City and  
14 County of San Francisco, including the West Span, West Approach, Central Freeway,  
15 Bayshore Viaduct Projects; and,

16 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Departments of Parking and Traffic and Public Works  
17 staff continues to work closely with the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), the  
18 Municipal Railway (Muni), local businesses and residents to coordinate all plans and designs  
19 for all temporary detours on City streets as part of the demolition and reconstruction of that  
20 portion of the aforementioned freeway segments; and,

21 WHEREAS, The City had entered into a Cooperative Agreement with the State as  
22 approved by the Board of Supervisors Resolution No. 536-99, which is hereby declared to be  
23 a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

24 WHEREAS, This original Cooperative Agreement stated that the total cost of providing  
25 engineering support was only \$331,000; and,

1 WHEREAS, The State is requesting additional City staff time and engineering support  
2 of these projects until June 30, 2009 or the completion of the West Approach Seismic Retrofit  
3 Project, whichever is earlier in time; and,

4 WHEREAS, The State wishes to execute an Amendment to the Cooperative  
5 Agreement with the Departments of Parking and Traffic and Public Works to fund these  
6 services provided by the City until June 30, 2009 or the completion of the West Approach  
7 Seismic Retrofit Project, whichever is earlier in time; and,

8 WHEREAS, Indirect costs are ineligible under state and federal rules and regulations;  
9 now, therefore, be it

10 RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors does hereby authorize the Executive  
11 Director of the Department of Parking and Traffic and the Director of the Department of Public  
12 Works to accept and expend up to \$2,560,000 in federal and state grant funds as  
13 reimbursement for providing design and construction engineering support to the California  
14 Department of Transportation for its seismic retrofit projects in the City and County of San  
15 Francisco, including the I-80 Western approach Retrofit Project and to execute all documents  
16 therefor.




