5 WHEREAS, The City of San Francisco is home to the most diverse population of
6 immigrants; and,

7 WHEREAS, The immigrant population is an integral part of San Francisco's cultural
8 richness and economic vibrancy; and,

9 WHEREAS, On August 26, 2002, San Francisco District Attorney Terence Hallinan
10 held a press conference calling for tolerance as the nation approaches the one-year
11 anniversary of "9/11"; and,

12 WHEREAS, District Attorney Hallinan launched the citywide Anti-Hate Campaign,
13 which will include 800 posters on bus tails, as well as inside buses and at some 30 buses
14 stops; and,

15 WHEREAS, The title of the poster will be "We are not the Enemy...We are your
16 community"; and,

17 WHEREAS, Community groups like the United Way, the Islamic Society of San
18 Francisco, the Intergroup Clearinghouse, the Alliance of South Asians Taking Action, and the
19 American Arab Anti-Defamation Center of San Francisco collaborated together to develop the
20 campaign; now therefore, be it,

21 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors endorses the citywide "Anti-Hate
22 Campaign" while reaffirming itself as a City and County of Refuge for all immigrants.


