14 Franciscans as well as visitors from surrounding areas

15 WHEREAS, It is incumbent upon the City of San Francisco to provide an organized
16 and safe environment for such a popular event as Halloween in the City of San Francisco;
17 now, therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED, That the Grants for the Arts, the San Francisco Police Department, the
19 Department of Parking and Traffic, the Department of Public Works, neighborhood groups,
20 community groups, and other interested parties must cohesively organize and plan for
21 Halloween 2003.




