14 previously reviewed and approved the JAIBG program plan; and

15 WHEREAS, the funding available provides continuation funding for existing
16 programs; and

17 WHEREAS, the positions authorized under the grant are designated as "G" or
18 "Grant Funded" positions which would terminate when the grant expires; and

19 WHEREAS, indirect costs are hereby requested to be waived in order to
20 maximize direct funding to programs; now, therefore, be it






