3 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the San Francisco Fire Department (SFFD) to**

5 **Management Agency (FEMA) to acquire 800 MHz portable radios for all firefighters**  
6 **working in suppression and to transfer from the California Fire Incident Reporting**  
7 **System (CFIRS) to the National Fire Incident Reporting System (NFIRS), for the period**  
8 **of September 15, 2002 through September 14, 2003.**

10 WHEREAS, SFFD has applied for and been awarded a grant from FEMA in the  
11 amount of \$409,633 to purchase 141 - 800MHz radios for all suppression personnel in the  
12 Fire Department and to transfer from CFIRS to NFIRS reporting as statutorily required by the  
13 State Fire Marshal's Office; and

14 WHEREAS, the Fire Department proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on  
15 program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

16 RESOLVED, That Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the  
17 grant budget; and, be it

18 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the SFFD is hereby authorized to retroactively accept  
19 and expend a grant in the amount of \$409,633 from FEMA.




