RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby extends the City Contracting Task Force's timeline to July 1, 2003; and,

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the members of the City Contracting Task Force shall be empowered to send a representative to meetings at which the member is unavailable.




