6 WHEREAS, Father Peter J. Sammon was a wonderful humanitarian and an
7 unrelenting activist for the under-served; and

8 WHEREAS, Father Sammon will be remembered most by his unwavering commitment
9 to the formation of leaders to work for social change; and,

10 WHEREAS, Father Sammon was an instrumental member of a coalition to pass a
11 resolution in 1984 to make San Francisco a City of Refuge for people seeking freedom and a
12 better life, which later became a city ordinance; and,

13 WHEREAS, Father Sammon was a co-founder of the San Francisco Organizing
14 Project (SFOP), a faith-based organization working to improve the quality of life for all families
15 in San Francisco; and,

16 WHEREAS, Father Sammon was also a founder of the Bay Area chapter of the
17 National Industrial Areas Foundation (IAF) working tirelessly for the Minimum Compensation
18 Ordinance raising the wages of 16,000 workers from \$6.00 to \$11.00 with health and pension
19 benefits; now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors in honor of Reverend Peter
21 Sammon, urge the DPW to rename 19th Street between Connecticut and Missouri Streets "
22 Peter Sammon Way."
