

1 [Retroactively Accept-Expend Federal and State Grants]

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3 Resolution authorizing the Department of Public Works to retroactively accept and expend a
4 grant in the amount of \$8,438,760 in Federal Highway Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation
5 (HBRR) program funds, \$9,977,898 in Federal Seismic funds, and \$2,494,475 in State
6 Seismic funds, for a total of \$20,911,134 in grant funds from the Federal Department of
7 Transportation (FHWA) through the State Department of Transportation (Caltrans) to
8 seismically retrofit and rehabilitate the Fourth Street Bridge over the Mission Bay Channel
9 Waterway in China Basin: reserving \$488,733 in grant funds that may be returned to the
10 General Fund without a need to release the reserve.

12 WHEREAS, The Fourth Street Bridge is a historical structure designed in 1915 and
13 constructed in 1917 and determined to be eligible for inclusion in the National Register of
14 Historic Places; and,

15 WHEREAS, Following the 1989 Loma Prieta earthquake, the City evaluated the Fourth
16 Street Bridge and, with concurrence from Caltrans, recommended that the bridge be brought
17 up to current seismic standards; and,

18 WHEREAS, The primary objective of the Fourth Street Bridge project is to provide
19 seismic retrofit work and rehabilitate the bridge and approaches to a fully serviceable
20 condition and to prevent collapse of the bridge during an earthquake; and,

21 WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works is eligible to receive Federal and/or State
22 funding for certain transportation projects through Caltrans; and,

23 WHEREAS, The Federal HBRR program was established by TEA-21 as a separate
24 program to provide assistance to states to replace or rehabilitate bridges that are significantly

1 important and are unsafe because of structural deficiencies, physical deterioration, or
2 functional obsolescence; and,

3 WHEREAS, The Fourth Street Bridge is on the Federal Structural Deficient /
4 Functionally Obsolete Selection list and thus qualified for Federal Seismic and HBRR funding;
5 and,

6 WHEREAS, The non-Federal share of the Fourth Street Bridge project will be paid for
7 with State Transportation Improvement Program funds totaling \$7,109,690 \$7,130,000 as the
8 source of the local match and \$2,494,475 in State Seismic funds; and,

9 WHEREAS, indirect costs are prohibited by the granting agency; now, therefore, be it

10 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby authorize the Director of
11 Public Works to retroactively accept and expend \$20,911,134 in federal and state grant funds
12 for the Fourth Street Bridge Seismic Retrofit and Rehabilitation Project and to execute any
13 and all documents necessary therefore; and, be it

14 FURTHER RESOLVED, That grant funds in the amount of \$488,733 are placed on
15 reserve to be released by the Finance Committee, except that these reserved funds may be
16 returned to the General Fund without the need to release the reserve.


