3 **Resolution appointing Joseph Berger and Steve Trent terms ending June 30, 2004 to**  
4 **the Union Square Business Improvement District Advisory Board; residency**  
5 **requirement waived.**

7 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
8 does hereby appoint the hereinafter designated persons to serve as members of the Union  
9 Square Business Improvement District Advisory Board, pursuant to the provisions resolution  
10 No. 1066-98, for the term specified:

11 Joseph Berger (residency requirement waived), succeeding Michael Cassidy, resigned,  
12 seat 2, must be property owner within the Business Improvement District for the unexpired  
13 portion of a 5 year term expiring June 30, 2004.

14 Steve Trent, succeeding Mark Heinzelman, deceased, seat 3, must be property owner  
15 within the Business Improvement District for the unexpired portion of a 5 year term expiring  
16 June 30, 2004; and, be it

17 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 18 1. The membership of the Union Square Business Improvement District Advisory  
19 Board has a goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and County of San  
20 Francisco.
- 21 2. Applicant Joseph Berger, new appointee, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is  
22 a person with experience that uniquely qualifies him to serve on the Union Square  
23 Business Improvement District Advisory Board.
- 24 3. The Union Square Business Improvement District Advisory Board has attempted to  
25 fill the position, for which Joseph Berger was nominated, with an individual who is a

1 City resident and who has the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has  
2 been unable to do so at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that Joseph  
3 Berger is qualified to serve on the Union Square Business Improvement District  
4 Advisory Board.

- 5 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there are no  
6 other possible representatives, who are residents of San Francisco and who have  
7 the specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and  
8 who are willing to serve on the Union Square Business Improvement District  
9 Advisory Board at this time; and, be it

10 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency  
11 requirement for Joseph Berger, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident, willing to  
12 serve, can be found, pursuant to Section 4.101 of the City Charter that requires person(s)  
13 appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the  
14 Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.
