WHEREAS, The Task Force presented it's final recommendations to the February 27th Meeting of the City Services Committee to include: (1) establishing a 24-hour hotline, (2) coordinating community street outreach and services, and (3) opening a secured housing program, which will be a residential program for girls 12-17., and, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors does hereby accept the recommendations from the Task Force to End the Exploitation of Youth presented at the hearing scheduled February 27, 2003 in the City Services Committee.

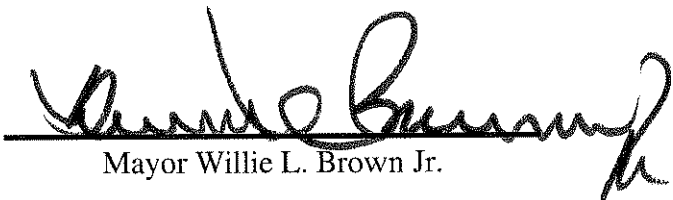
