19 WHEREAS, Armando Miranda, has fully embraced the Drug Court philosophy of  
20 focusing on the larger picture of the participants' recovery and, to that end, repeatedly makes  
21 creative participant-specific suggestions that are effective in assisting his clients in achieving  
22 sobriety and crime-free lives; and,

23 WHEREAS, Armando Miranda has shown unbounded compassion, concern and  
24 respect for Drug Court participants; now, therefore, be it
