3 **Resolution urging the Department of Parking and Traffic and the Department of Public**  
4 **Works to implement the Stockton Street Enhancement Plan.**

6 WHEREAS, the Department of Parking and Traffic (DPT) and Chinatown Community  
7 Development Center (Chinatown CDC) received a Metropolitan Transportation Commission  
8 Transportation for Livable Communities Planning Grant for the Stockton Street corridor from  
9 the northern mouth of the Stockton Street tunnel to Broadway; and

10 WHEREAS, DPT and Chinatown CDC has conducted a series of community meetings  
11 on the Stockton Street Enhancement Plan with their consultant CHS Consulting to do a field  
12 survey and analysis; and

13 WHEREAS, Stockton Street is the most vibrant and congested corridor in Chinatown  
14 as well as a vital thoroughfare in the city's transportation network; and

15 WHEREAS, the Stockton Street Enhancement Plan identifies pedestrian and transit  
16 enhancements to improve the corridor by promoting safety for pedestrians, increasing  
17 efficiency in pedestrian traffic and buses, and encouraging greater availability of parking  
18 spaces throughout the area; and

19 RESOLVED, That San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges the implementation of the  
20 Stockton Street Enhancement Plan be the official policy of the DPT and the DPW, and that  
21 these departments work in cooperation with merchants and community groups including the  
22 Stockton Street Commercial Corridor Group as well as other government agencies.


