17 this resource to help stimulate economic activity, foster meaningful cultural exchange and
18 develop more earned income opportunities for our artists; and,

19 WHEREAS, San Francisco's arts community can collaborate to make this a success
20 because of our existing infrastructure, our rich artistic resources; and private matching funds;
21 and now, therefore be it
