6 following intersections are hereby designated as "STOP" intersections, and the
7 Department of Parking and Traffic is hereby authorized and directed to cause "STOP"
8 signs to be installed thereat as designated below:

10 22nd Avenue and Pacheco Street, stopping Pacheco Street, making this
11 intersection an All-Way STOP; and
12 Niagara and San Jose Avenues, stopping San Jose Avenue, making this
13 intersection an All-Way STOP.

15 Categorically exempt from Environmental
16 Review Class 1(c)(9) changes in the traffic and
17 parking regulations where such changes do not
18 establish a higher speed limit or result in more
19 than a negligible increase in the use of the
20 street.




