3 **Resolution authorizing the Municipal Transportation Agency to accept and expend**  
4 **\$2,441,395 of United States Department of Justice, 2003 Urban Area Security Initiative**  
5 **grant funds to develop and implement security enhancements for the San Francisco**  
6 **Municipal Railway.**

8 WHEREAS, The United States Department of Justice (DOJ) is authorized to make  
9 monies available for the Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) Grant Program; and

10 WHEREAS, Congress has dedicated funding from the DOJ 2003 UASI Grant Program  
11 for implementation of security enhancements at numerous transit systems throughout the  
12 country; and

13 WHEREAS, The Municipal Transportation Agency, City and County of San Francisco,  
14 is an eligible claimant for DOJ 2003 UASI Grant Program funds because the San Francisco  
15 Municipal Railway is among 20 transit systems in the country identified as a high threat mass  
16 transit system eligible to participate in this program; and

17 WHEREAS, No local matching funds are required; and


18 WHEREAS, The Director of Transportation (or his designee) must execute agreements  
19 to complete transfer of the grant funds; now, therefore, be it


20 RESOLVED, That the MTA is authorized to accept and expend \$2,441,395 in funding  
21 from DOJ 2003 UASI Grant Program funds for various Muni transit system security  
22 enhancements; and, be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the MTA is authorized to furnish whatever additional  
24 information or assurances that might be requested by the funding agencies in connection with  
25 this request; and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the MTA is authorized to execute any and all agreements  
2 necessary to complete transfer of these funds.
