14 educational institution; and,

15 WHEREAS, Youth Chance High School has provided educational and employment
16 development opportunities for thousands of teens and young adults from San Francisco; and

17 WHEREAS, The curriculum at Youth Chance High School emphasizes GED and
18 California High School Proficiency Exam preparation; as well as important skills such as
19 critical thinking, employment readiness training, college or vocational preparation, and
20 financial literacy, and independent living skills; and,


