8 cut entitlements and specifically targets Medicaid and the Earned Income Tax Credit,
9 reducing the EITC by \$3 billion over five years; and

11 very large tax breaks for the wealthiest Americans by accelerating repeal of the estate tax and
12 making other tax cuts permanent and increases the budget deficit, even as it cuts spending;

22 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors directs the Clerk of the Board
23 to send a copy of this resolution to Senators Dianne Feinstein and Barbara Boxer.
