6 Code and the San Francisco Traffic Code, the following regulations governing the
7 parking of vehicles are hereby enacted or rescinded as designated below:

8 **RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA "U" (2-HOUR TIME LIMIT, 8 AM - 10 PM,**
9 **MONDAY THRU SUNDAY) - ESTABLISH**

10 1126 - 1130 Harrison Street, north side, between 7th and 8th Streets (Signs will
11 not be posted on this street, but residents will be able to purchase
permits).

12 1161 - 1161A Harrison Street and 1163 - 1165 Harrison Street, south side,
13 between 7th and 8th Streets (Signs will not be posted on this street, but
residents will be able to purchase permits).

14 Categorically exempt from Environmental
15 Review Class 1(c)(9) changes in the traffic and
16 parking regulations where such changes do not
17 establish a higher speed limit or result in more
than a negligible increase in the use of the
street.
