

1 [Resolution to Initiate the Designation of 900 Innes Avenue, the Hunter's Point School, as a  
2 City Landmark]

3 **Resolution initiating the designation of 900 Innes Avenue, the Hunter's Point School,**  
4 **Block 4646, Lot 03, as a City landmark pursuant to Planning Code Section 1004.1.**

6 WHEREAS, 900 Innes Avenue , described in this resolution as the Hunter's Point  
7 School, is a small wood frame Italianate-style cottage used as a school as early as 1897 for  
8 the surrounding community; and,  
9

10 WHEREAS, the Hunter's Point School appears significant under National Register  
11 Criterion A (Patterns of History) by virtue of its important role in the shipwright, boat repair and  
12 marine community of India Basin; and,  
13

14 WHEREAS, the Hunter's Point School appears significant under National Register  
15 Criterion C (Design/Construction) as an excellent example of an Italianate-style cottage, with  
16 a quality of workmanship that reflects the work of a ship carpenter with decorative features  
17 reminiscent of decorative ship molding; and,  
18

19 WHEREAS, the Hunter's Point School possesses integrity of design, materials and  
20 workmanship, as it has been little changed since its construction; and  
21

22 WHEREAS, Hunter's Point School has a special character and special historical,  
23 architectural and aesthetic interest and value; now, therefore, be it  
24

25 RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors does hereby initiate the  
designations of the Hunter's Point School, 900 Innes Avenue, Block 4646, lot 3, as a landmark,  
and so directs the Landmarks Preservation Advisory Board to place the property in  
consideration as a landmark pursuant to Article 10 of the Planning Code and other  
appropriate provisions of law.


