9 WHEREAS, MOCJ is the lead programmatic and fiscal agency in administering the
10 OVW grant; and

11 WHEREAS, San Francisco applied and was awarded on September 13, 2004, five
12 hundred ninety-nine thousand, one hundred and two dollars (\$599,102); and,

13 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Sheriff's Department, District Attorney's Office and
14 Department on the Status of Women will be responsible for all day to day operations of the
15 three components of this grant; and

16 WHEREAS, MOCJ will be responsible for the fiscal and programmatic reporting to
17 OJP; and

18 WHEREAS, In order to maximize direct services indirect costs are requested to be
19 waived; now, therefore, be it


20 RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco hereby authorizes MOCJ to




