3 **Resolution authorizing the Mayor's Office of Criminal Justice (MOCJ) to retroactively**
4 **accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$989,477 from the U.S. Department of**
5 **Justice (DOJ), Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS Office) for the**
6 **purpose of integrating the case management system for the JUSTIS Project. The new**
7 **system will integrate the case management systems serving the Police, Sheriff, District**
8 **Attorney, Public Defender, Adult Probation and the Superior Court. It will make the**
9 **sharing of information within the criminal justice community easier, more efficient and**
10 **accurate.**

11 WHEREAS, MOCJ is the lead programmatic and fiscal agency in administering the
12 2004 Technology Grant Initiative: San Francisco Police Department RMS Deployment &
13 JUSTIS Integration Project; and

14 WHEREAS, San Francisco applied and was awarded on November 8, 2004, nine
15 hundred eighty-nine thousand and four hundred seventy-seven dollars (\$989,477); and

16 WHEREAS, The Mayor's Office of Criminal Justice and the San Francisco Department
17 of Public Health in partnership with the San Francisco Police Department, District Attorney's
18 Office will be responsible for coordination and day-to-day operations of the planning and
19 implementation phases of this grant; and

20 WHEREAS, MOCJ will be responsible for the fiscal, programmatic and administrative
21 reporting to the COPS Office; and now therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco hereby authorizes MOCJ to
23 retroactively accept and expend \$989,477 from the DOJ, COPS Office to administer the 2004
24 Technology Grant Initiative: San Francisco Police Department RMS Deployment & JUSTIS
25 Integration Project.




