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3 **Resolution enacting and rescinding parking regulations at various locations.**

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5 RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of the California Vehicle
6 Code and the San Francisco Traffic Code, the following regulations governing the
7 parking of vehicles are hereby enacted or rescinded as designated below:

8 **TOW-AWAY, NO PARKING ANYTIME - ESTABLISH**

9 John Muir Drive, south side, from 50 feet east of the east property line of the
10 Lakewood Apartments (end of angled parking) to Lake Merced Boulevard.

11 **TOW-AWAY, NO PARKING, 10 PM to 6 AM EVERYDAY - ESTABLISH**

12 John Muir Drive, north side, from 50 feet east of the east property line of the
13 Lakewood Apartments (end of angled parking) to Lake Merced Boulevard.

Categorically exempt from Environmental
Review Class 1(c)(9) changes in the traffic and
parking regulations where such changes do not
establish a higher speed limit or result in more
than a negligible increase in the use of the
street.


