Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) to accept retroactively and expend a new grant in the amount of \$25,000 from the March of Dimes Foundation (MODF) for the Smoke Free Pregnancy Project, to enter into an agreement for the use of these funds, and to add one new position funded through this grant; for the period of January 1, 2005, to December 31, 2005.

WHEREAS, SFDPH has applied for and been awarded a Smoke Free Pregnancy Project grant from MODF in the amount of \$25,000 to improve pregnancy outcomes; and,

WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, MODF requires the City to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. <u>050139</u>, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

WHEREAS, This Resolution requires expedited review by the Board of Supervisors because the award was not received from MODF until after the grant start date of January 1, 2005; and,

WHEREAS, Resolutions authorizing the acceptance and expenditure of grant funds may be placed automatically on the consent agendas in committee, as they are usually considered to be routine items, and this resolution authorizes the acceptance and expenditure of grant funding; and,

WHEREAS, One temporary, part-time position will be added through this grant; and, WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

Supervisors Alioto-Pier, Dufty Department Of Public Health BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept retroactively and expend a grant in the amount of \$25,000 from MODF; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the budget of the Agreement; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend the grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10-170-1; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the position funded under this agreement as a "G" or grant-funded position which would terminate when the agreement expires.
