5 RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of the California Vehicle
6 Code and the San Francisco Traffic Code, the following regulations governing the
7 movement of vehicles are hereby enacted or rescinded as designated below:

LEFT LANE MUST TURN LEFT - RESCIND

Anza Street, eastbound, at Masonic Avenue.

NO LEFT TURN - RESCIND

Twin Peaks Boulevard, northbound, onto westbound Carmel Street

NO LEFT TURN - ESTABLISH

13

505 Parnassus Avenue driveway exit (mid-block between 3rd Avenue and Hillway
Street).

RIGHT OR LEFT TURNS ONLY - ESTABLISH

Baker Street, northbound, at Turk Street.

Categorically exempt from Environmental
Review Class 1(c)(9) changes in the traffic and
parking regulations where such changes do not
establish a higher speed limit or result in more
than a negligible increase in the use of the
street.


