

1 [Urging Governor Schwarzenegger to re-visit California's "Three Strikes" law.

3 **Resolution urging Governor Schwarzenegger to re-visit the "Three Strikes" law**
4 **adopted by California voters and the state legislature in 1994.**

5 WHEREAS, The original "Three Strikes" law under Penal Code section 667.7
6 mandated a 20 year sentence for a third violent conviction and a life sentence for a fourth
7 violent conviction and,
8

9 WHEREAS, The new version of the "Three Strikes" law passed by California voters in
10 1994 broadened the qualifications for the first two "strikes" to include not just violent offenses
11 but also offenses deemed "serious," and it allows any type of felony conviction to constitute a
12 third strike and,

13 WHEREAS, With these new qualifications defendants like Santos Reyes are serving a life
14 sentence for giving false information on a Department of Motor Vehicles driver's license test
15 to help his cousin and,

16 WHEREAS, The first of Santos Reyes' "strikes" was for burglary committed as a juvenile
17 and the second, a robbery, which occurred 10 years before the third strike and,

18 WHEREAS, The crimes committed by Santos Reyes do not appear to have resulted in
19 physical harm to another person, have sentenced him to life in jail under the new "Three
20 Strikes" law and,

21 WHEREAS, There are 4,200 nonviolent offenders like Reyes that are currently in
22 prison under "Three Strikes" serving terms that were previously reserved for individuals who
23 have been convicted of murder, mayhem, and serious sex offenses and


