5 WHEREAS, The California Million Solar Roofs bill (SB1) is the most ambitious solar
6 legislation ever introduced in the United States and would provide ten years of incentives to
7 help bring solar energy into the mainstream in California; and,

8 WHEREAS, Solar energy provides a clean, safe source of energy for California that
9 helps reduce air pollution, fight global warming and increase energy independence; and,

11 WHEREAS, Solar energy produces electricity during peak demand when energy is
12 most needed and most expensive; and

14 WHEREAS, Solar energy allows electricity to be generated at the source where it is
15 consumed and helps strengthen the electricity grid and reduce our vulnerability to rolling
16 blackouts or other failures of the electric grid; and

17 WHEREAS, San Francisco strongly supports the rapid expansion of solar and other
18 renewable sources of energy to reduce our dependence on fossil fuels; now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of that San Francisco


