3 Resolution authorizing the Department of the District Attorney of the City and County  
4 of San Francisco to retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$562,287  
5 through the California Governor’s Office of Emergency Services, Criminal Justice  
6 Programs Division, for the operation of a program entitled “Victim & Witness  
7 Assistance Program.”

9 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco desires to continue a certain project  
10 designated the San Francisco Victim & Witness Assistance Program, to be funded in part  
11 from funds made available through the Governor’s Office of Emergency Services, Criminal  
12 Justice Programs Division (CJPD); and,

13 WHEREAS, All positions supported by these funds shall be coded “G” in the District  
14 Attorney’s budget; and,

15 WHEREAS, The terms of the grant prohibit inclusion of indirect costs in the grant  
16 budget; now, therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the District Attorney of the City  
18 and County of San Francisco to retroactively accept and expend funds from CJPD for the  
19 purposes of victim & witness assistance program; and, be it


20 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of  
21 indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it


22 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the District Attorney is authorized to execute on behalf of  
23 the City and County of San Francisco the necessary Grant Award Agreements for purposes of  
24 the victim & witness assistance program, including any extensions, augmentations or  
25 amendments thereof; and be it


1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the District Attorney is authorized and empowered to  
2 execute, deliver and perform, in the name of the City and County of San Francisco, all  
3 applications, contracts, agreements, amendments and payment requests necessary for the  
4 purpose of securing Victim & Witness Assistance Program grant funds and to implement and  
5 carry out the purposes specified in the applicable grant application; and be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That any liability arising out of the performance of the Grant  
7 Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the  
8 grant recipient and the authorizing agency; and be it

9 FURTHER RESOLVED, That grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to  
10 supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
